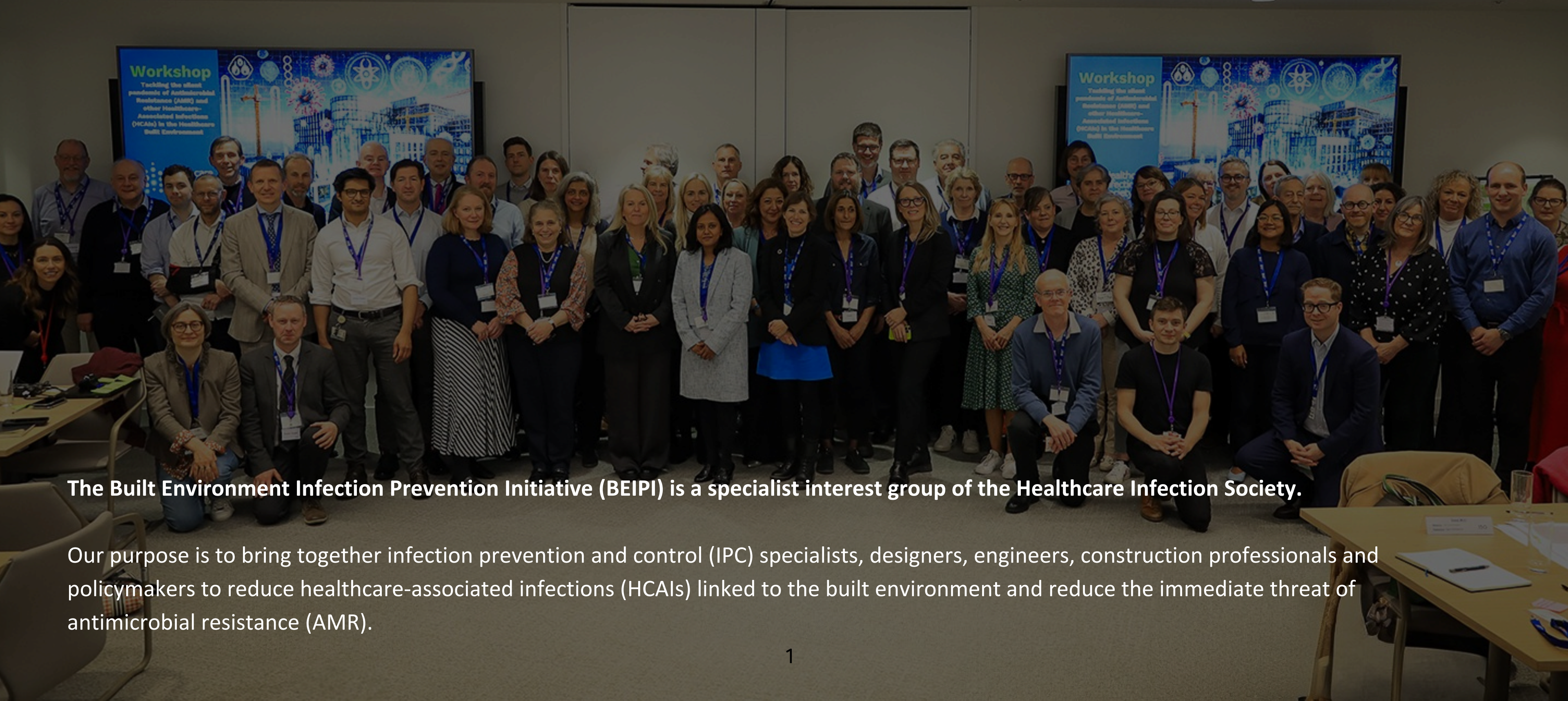

The Built Environment Infection Prevention Initiative (BEIPI) is a specialist interest group of the Healthcare Infection Society.

Our purpose is to bring together infection prevention and control (IPC) specialists, designers, engineers, construction professionals and policymakers to reduce healthcare-associated infections (HCAIs) linked to the built environment and reduce the immediate threat of antimicrobial resistance (AMR).
